

Bosmere Eco Club Pupils' Suggestions for Questions to add to the Environmental Review

- Do you ask pupils to bring things in which the school can get recycled or give parents information about where things can be recycled locally e.g. small electrical equipment, used batteries, milk bottle tops, used dental products or stamps.
- Does every class collect used pens for recycling?
- Do you have school clubs to encourage pupils to take more physical exercise, to learn about diet and nutrition, or to tackle mental health e.g. through mindfulness or brain games & quizzes?
- Do you have an eco governor who tells the governors about eco club activities and achievements in school?
- Do you ever have paper-free days to save on photocopying and printing?
- Do you ever have a stationery amnesty so you don't keep buying pens and exercise books which aren't needed?
- Does your school take part in national eco challenges like the Clean Air Scooter Challenge or the Let's Go Zero National Schools Action Day?
- Does your school have a sustainability policy?
- Does your school support any wildlife charities or learn about conservation organisations?
- Do you have books about eco issues in the school library?
- Do you save energy by turning down the heating and wearing warmer clothes in the winter, or opening windows instead of using fans or air conditioning in the summer?
- Do you use any ways of controlling the watering of plants outdoors e.g. making recycled plastic bottle watering systems?
- Do you encourage pupils to use less toilet paper (because this will save water by reducing toilet flushing and save money too)?

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
