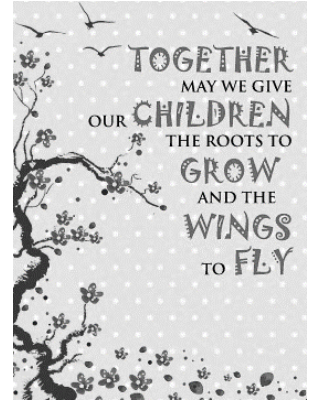


## Year 3 Information pack

Welcome to the Year 3 Information Pack. We hope this tells you everything you need to know about life and learning expectations in Year 3. In your pack you will find:

- Recommended reads for Year 3
- Suggested questions for adults to use during reading
- The statutory Year 3/4 spelling list
- Common Spelling Rules



We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of the following:

**PE/Games** - This takes place on Monday and Wednesday afternoons and children should come to school in their PE kits (please do not worry if yours has not yet arrived!).

**Book Bags** - Please ensure your child brings their book bag (or a suitable alternative) every day, containing their reading diary, reading book and homework book.

**Reading Diaries** - These are collected in every Monday morning and checked for signatures and reading progress.

**Homework** - Homework project tasks are in your child's purple homework book. At least one project based task should be completed each half term. Please enjoy completing these tasks with your child.

**Reading at Home** - Your child should be reading at least 5 times a week, and even our most confident readers should be reading aloud with an adult. We encourage adults and older siblings to read as often as possible. Please do not underestimate the power and magic of bedtime stories! **Spelling and times tables tests** - Spelling tests take place on a Wednesday and tables tests take place in maths lessons throughout the week. By the end of Year 4, children should know and be able to apply all of their times tables up to 12x. Every child is subscribed to Times Tables Rockstars

### Weekly Overview

**Monday** - children wear PE kits and need to bring their signed reading diaries into school.

**Wednesday** - children wear PE kits to school, need their homework books and have spelling tests

### Parent Pack Contents

These packs are found on our website and are also attached to this letter. They contain:

- **A list of age-appropriate recommended reading books**
- **Questions** to ask when reading at home.
- **200 high frequency words** - (only found in year 3 / 4 packs)
- **Statutory spellings** - the government demands that pupils should know how to read and spell all of these words by the end of Year 4 or 6. Again, please use this list at home to support your child's spelling.
- **Key maths facts**
- **Examples of times tables test**-children are expected to know the division and multiplication fact and be able to apply theses to decimals and fraction
- **Common spelling rules**
