Thank you very much for reading the Year 4 information in your child's homework book. Here is just a brief reminder of the key information.

Monday - children should come to school in their PE kit

Monday - signed reading diary (children need to read at least 5 times with an adult)

Wednesday - spelling and times table/MyMaths homework given out/due in

Thursday - children should come to school in their PE kit

Maths homework will follow a three week rotation:

Week 1: Times table booklet

Week 2: Times table booklet

We expect children to be using Times Tables Rock Stars daily. It is vitally important that children are fluent with their times tables as they are used throughout the maths curriculum in Years 3-6 and in secondary school. <https://trockstars.com/>

Your child should also be accessing Read Theory regularly at home. This can count towards their 5 reads for the week. <https://readtheory.org/>

N.B. All of the logins that children need to use will be in their homebook books again (just like in Y3).
