Responsibilities:

- Take responsibility for the e-Safety worry box within the year group
- Report e-Safety issues to Mr Wood or Mr Adam
- Attend half termly meetings
- Deliver e-Safety lessons to other children within the school
- Be involved in decisions about e-Safety advice sent to parents
- Occasionally write letters to parents
- Attend training at other schools or with other providers.

- Great communication
- Able to work with adults and children
- Self motivated
- e-Safety knowledge

Always on hand to deal with immediate issues, regular check of e safety boxes, half termly meetings
