# Polly is in Year 3 and has 90\% attendance. <br> Is that GOOD? - Great result for an exam! <br> BUT IT IS A VERY POOR RESULT FOR AN ATTENDANCE ACHIEVEMENT. 

So what does it mean if Polly does no $\dagger$ come to school? $90 \%$ attendance = half a day missed each week.

Over a year this would be equal to missing 4 whole weeks of lessons.

Over just 3 years at Bosmere School, this would be the equivalent of one whole term missed.

## How can you help to get your child to school every day?

Only allow your child to stay home for genuine illness.
Please do not take holidays in term time.

## Every Minute Counts

- Children need to be in their classroom by 8.50am.
- Children arriving after this time and before the official close of the register at 9.05am will be marked late (L).
- If a child arrives after 9.20am it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence for the morning session (U).
- If a child is late (U) 10 times within a 10 week period a Penalty Notice may be issued.

Please remember that the playground gates are locked at 8.50am and after this time children will need to enter school through the front door.
