Pupils from schools in Havant and Emsworth worked together to create online safety videos to share at their schools and with the wider community to warn them of some of the dangers they might meet online. Children from Bosmere Junior School, Emsworth Primary School and Fairfield Infant School were supported by the digital leaders from Warblington School as they designed and filmed e-safety messages.

The digital leaders, eleven and twelve year old pupils from Warblington School, helped the younger children use the application Adobe Spark to create their video messages.
